Fujio Ohmori has been Professor at the Institute for Excellence in Higher Education, Tohoku University since April 2016 after thirteen years of serving as a professor at another two institutions, namely, first Kumamoto University and then Tokyo Metropolitan University. Before joining academia, he worked at Japan's Ministry of Education for approximately twenty years.

He graduated from Kyoto University as a sociologist in 1982, and received PhD from the Institute of Education, University of London in 2008. His research interest lies in sociological analysis of education in general and higher education in particular. His research projects, funded by the Japanese government's research grant scheme (Kakenhi), covered the issues of 'postgraduates' employability', 'PhD holders as temporary staff at universities', 'leadership, management and governance in higher education', and 'international and transnational higher education'. Currently he is engaging in two Kakenhi projects on the themes of "discipline-based education research and professional and organizational development to raise learning outcomes in higher education" and "Comparative analysis of higher education governance from the viewpoints of political economy".
