Hannah Meadley-Roberts joined the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) in April 2013 as Director of the President's Office. Between 2008 and 2010 Hannah was Private Secretary to the Permanent Secretary assisting in dealing with key issues affecting the MoJ as well as sensitive political negotiations, organisational development and stakeholder handling.
