

Tohoku University International Award and International Alumni Association Awards 2024 Nomination Guidelines

I. Background and Purpose

Tohoku University wishes to recognize alumni from all over the world, particularly those who have achieved success in academic, cultural, and social activities and who have thus contributed to Tohoku University's international presence. Tohoku University also wishes to recognize activities planned and implemented primarily by Tohoku University alumni that are distinctive or have significantly improved relations between Tohoku University and its alumni or between the organizers and other alumni.

II. Nomination Schedule

- End of June : we will begin accepting nominations.
- August 30: deadline for the nominations (Category I & Category II) .
- September: review of the nominations by Tohoku University board members.
- September 28: The winners will be announced at Tohoku University's 117th Anniversary Home Coming Day.
- December: Awards ceremony.

III. The Awards

(1) Award Categories

Category I: Individual Award

Tohoku University International Award

This award is given, in principle, to one active Tohoku University alumnus or former employee. The award recognizes and honors an alumnus or former employee who, residing outside Japan, have made a significant positive contribution to the society and university's international presence through academic, cultural, or social activities.

Category II: Alumni Association Award

Tohoku University Alumni Activity Award

This award is given to one alumni association for remarkable initiatives that promote the university's international presence to the younger generations, make a significant contribution to the society, or support the Alumni Association in strengthening its alumni network. (e.g., organize public seminars and workshops on areas of competence, alumni networking events, and so on)

(2) Prizes *

Award certificate and invitation to the Awards Ceremony (travel expenses will be covered by Tohoku University)
The association that has been chosen as the winner of Category II will send one person as its representative.

*The contents of the supplementary prize are subject to change.

IV. Nomination Conditions

(1) Requirements

Nominees must meet all the following requirements to be considered.

Category I (Recommended by others)

The nominees for the prize must be recommended by third parties (i.e. they cannot recommend themselves)

Category II (Self-Recommendation)

- The organizer must be a group of three or more members (regardless of whether the members are of the same nationality).
- At least two-thirds of the organizers must be Tohoku University alumni and registered members of the Tohoku University Alumni Network.

(2) Eligible Nominees/Initiatives

For nominees and initiatives to be eligible, the following conditions must be met:

Category I

In general, Tohoku University alumni, former employees, and all those with a connection to the university, living outside Japan, who have made significant contributions to Tohoku University's international presence through academic, cultural, and social activities are eligible.

Category II

Held an activities or initiatives with fully documented from July 1st, 2023, to August 31st, 2024 by alumni associations who meet the conditions as below:

- The event must be distinctive, such as an event that enhances the university's international presence, contributes substantially to the local community, or expands the alumni network, and, in principle, the number of participants must be 30 or more.
- The event must have been organized to introduce Tohoku University to the younger generation, with at least 30 people in attendance.

* The initiatives can be either online or offline events.

V. How to Nominate

(1) Nominations

Category I

1. Resume and a list of achievements by the individual being recommended
2. Recommendation letter (Reasons for Recommendation)
3. Submit newspaper articles, clippings, photographs, and additional materials in PDF format.

Category II

1. Tohoku University International Association Awards forms
2. Video or photo documentation indicating that the initiatives are taking place (or have taken place). The video duration should be approximately 1 to 3 minutes.

* Slides with still images are acceptable if there is no archive video for initiatives that have already finished before the awards nomination process was announced.
